

TOWN OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 04/03

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MORRIS TO CLOSE A MUNICIPAL ROAD AND AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF LAND.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

- 290(1) “Subject to subsection (2), a municipality may close a municipal road by
- (a) passing a by-law closing the road; and
 - (b) obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and
 - (c) registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office.”
- 291(2) “A municipality may authorize the sale of land on which was situated a municipal road that has to or is to be closed under section 290 only with the written approval of the minister.”

AND WHEREAS the following described municipal road is no longer required for public purposes and necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the road be closed;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Morris enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** all that portion of Public Lane in Block 16, Plan No. 23 (MO Div.) Shown as Parcel A on a Plan prepared by James Taylor Wood, Manitoba Land Surveyor and sworn to by him on the 11th day of February, 2003 in RL 337 and 339, Parish of Ste. Agathe. (WLTO Deposit No. 146/2003), be and the same is hereby closed.
2. **THAT** all that portion of the municipal road so closed shall be transferred to Allen & Marlene Siemens, except all mines and minerals, title to which shall remain in the Crown; and the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the transfer.

**TOWN OF MORRIS
BY-LAW 14/02**

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MORRIS FOR THE CLOSING OF MUNICIPAL ROADS.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act Chapter 225 provides in part, as follows:

290(1)

“A municipality may close a municipal road by

- a) passing a by-law closing the road;
- b) obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and
- c) registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office”

290(2)

“A municipality may authorize the sale of land on which was situated a municipal road that has been or is to be closed under section 290 only with the written approval of the minister”

AND WHEREAS the following municipal roads are no longer required for public purposes and it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the following roads be closed;

AND WHEREAS the conditions and requirements of subsection 290(2) have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Morris enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** all that portion of the municipal road described as

Be and the same is hereby closed.

2. **THAT** all that portion of the municipal roads so closed shall be transferred to _____ excepting all mines and minerals, title to which shall remain in the Crown; and chief administrative officer is authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the transfer.
